

NOTICE OF MEETING

FULSHEAR MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF FORT BEND COUNTY

The Board of Directors of Fulshear Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Fort Bend County will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, August 28 2024, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2600, Brazos Conference Room**, Houston, Texas*, to discuss and, if appropriate, approve and act upon the following items:

1. Comments from the public (5 minute limit).
2. Approve minutes.
3. Approve audit for fiscal year end April 30, 2024.
4. District website matters.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, requests for estimates of value, and payment of tax bills.
7. Discuss 2024 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate.
8. Series 2024 Unlimited Tax Bonds, including:
 - a. review bids and award sale of the District's \$12,000,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2024;
 - b. adopt Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of the District's \$12,000,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2024;
 - c. approve Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement;
 - d. approve Official Statement;
 - e. execution of Certificate Regarding Provision of Financial Advice;
 - f. authorize the Board of Directors to sign all documents relating to the bond sale and authorize attorney and financial advisor to take all necessary action to deliver bonds to the purchaser;
 - g. approve payment to Attorney General relating to bond issue transcript review;
 - h. execution of Amendment to Information Form; and
 - i. update from District engineer on Texas Commission on Environmental Quality inspection of facilities.

9. Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement of bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, substantial completion, authorize final acceptance of projects, termination, pending or contemplated litigation, settlement, tender, release, and substitution agreements, direct engineer to notify insurance company, proposals, and service agreements, as appropriate, for construction projects, including for the following:
 - a. Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek, Section 11, including:
 - i. water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and
 - ii. paving facilities.
 - b. erosion protection along Fulshear Creek bank and channel east of District boundary, including Emergency Watershed Protection Program, agreement(s) with Natural Resources Conservation Service, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers nationwide permit, survey proposals, rights of entry, and service agreements;
 - c. City of Fulshear emergency James Lane water line extension project;
 - d. other engineering matters, including resident requests; and
 - e. utility commitments.
10. Accept and convey deeds and easements and approve related phase I environmental proposals, and consents to encroachment of easements.
11. Approve Utility Conveyance and Security Agreements, including:
 - a. Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek, Section 17 including Lift Station No. 10.
12. Discuss maintenance of southern detention facility matters, including request from the Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek Homeowners Association related to aquatic vegetation.
13. Park projects, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, substantial completion, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, including for the following:
 - a. Parkside Passage Drive Recreation Center;
 - b. landscape development of Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek, Section 7; and
 - c. greenway enhancements perimeter walls to serve Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek, Sections 5, 6, 7 and 19, including repairs to existing greenway enhancements perimeter walls.
14. Mowing and maintenance of District property, including discuss recovery from Hurricane Beryl, resident requests, proposals, and updates on previously approved proposals.
15. Report on development.
16. City of Fulshear ("City") matters, including water, sewer, drainage, park and street facilities, tax rebate, utility agreement and development agreement with the City regarding Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek, and City ordinances regarding development and land use.

17. Discuss meeting schedule.
18. Comments from the public (5 minute limit).
19. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
20. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
